
Let's Review....

Chapter 10 begins the portion of 2 Corinthians that some scholars believe is the "severe letter." Chapters 10–13

It is an Apologetic Letter. That is, one that brings charges against the opposite arguments with proof. (Paul Barnett, NIV Commentary on 2 Corinthians)

Paul is refuting the criticisms others have brought against him.

The Meaning of BOASTING

In Greek, <u>Kauchema</u>, "that of which one glories or can glory"

Kauchema used 21 times in this letter and most frequently in chapters 10-13


Paul's meaning is more like "confidence" or "justifiable pride" than some kind of self-glorification (Paul Barnett)




















First known description of the appearance of the Apostle Paul

Meaning of Stronghold

In the original Greek stronghold is the word "ochuroma": meaning a fortress, strong defense, stronghold

In 2 Corinthians 10:4, ochuroma is used figuratively and means a false argument in which a person seeks "shelter" (a safe place or stronghold) to escape reality. Strong's Greek Concordance


