
MODERN VERSION

ARIANISM: Jesus Christ is not equal to God the Father but is the first creation of God.



Jesus Christ was a good teacher, a wise rabbi, a martyr for a noble cause—but he was not God.

MARCIONISM: Message of the gospel is love and grace and the God of Jesus Christ is not the God of the Old Testament.



God is not a God of judgment, He is a God of love and acceptance. Salvation is offered to everyone.

PELAGIANISM: denied original sin, believed man can fulfill the law of God without the aid of grace.




We can be good and please God if we try hard enough.




A Jesus Who Fits the Modern World Better than the Jesus of the Gospels

The "Lost" Gospel of Judas--2006




- •Not new--this book was part of the discovery of ancient texts at Nag Hammadi in Egypt in 1945 and was well known by scholars.
- •Written by an early Christian sect around 180 AD.
- •A new translation of the restored text was released with great fanfare during Lent in 2006 by the National Geographic which had a cover article in its magazine and a documentary on its cable channel.
- •This book contradicts the Gospel accounts of Jesus' betrayal and portrays Judas as a hero who betrayed Jesus because Jesus asked him to.

The "Lost Tomb of Jesus"--2007 A Derivative of The Da Vinci Code



- Discovery Channel documentary, Lent 2007, claimed Jesus' remains had been found in a family tomb in east Jerusalem.
- The tomb contained 10 ossuaries that included the names Joseph, Mary, and Jesus.
- •Tomb contained remains of a woman named "Mariamne" speculated to be Mary Magdalene and Jesus' wife and the remains of "Jude, son of Jesus"

•Archaeologist William Dever said that he and others have known about these ossuaries for many years and thought it meant nothing because the names were so common. He called the "discovery" a publicity stunt.
