


### 2 Corinthians 10:4







Wednesday, April 3, 13

Some 22 trials listed, including...


I have been in danger from everyone, everywhere.


Three times I was shipwrecked.

Paul's response: (Acts 27:23-25)


He listens to God, and he believes what he hears.

May alienate some


Considered "boasting"


Paul's response:

He is obedient. (2 Cor 12:4)










#### Paul's thorn

"thorn" Greek skoloy -- a pointed piece of wood, a sharp stake

"torment" Greek *kholaphizo--* to strike with the fist, to treat with violence.




Paul's response:

# Paul's Responses to change


He prays.
