


What prompted God to act on our behalf?


Present & Future

Good Works and Grace



For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 2:10 NIV

Our aim is to do good works not for the purpose of securing a reward but deeds done as a response to the gift of grace we've received.

Key Passage

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God. Eph 2:8

Grace is God initiated, God given, and God powered.



Faith is our response to God's generous gift of grace. Faith is the human response by which God's salvation is received.

"Your own doing" implies work done by human effort. Salvation is not based on human performance or on any effort to win God's approval. Grace is a gift. Therefore, the *credit and praise* goes to God! *Soli Deo Gloria!*
