

The Ten

Definition

Coveting is a desire for something with



the goal of possession at any cost.

With the 10th Commandment, God moves from:

- Actions to Attitudes
- Motions to Motives
- Forbidden deeds to forbidden desires.

Ability to Produce

Love (John 3:16)
Truth (Psalm 19:7-10)
Spiritual Gifts (I Corinthians 12)
Nature (Genesis 1:26-31)

When our God-given desires go amuck, that is covetousness.

God Denies Us



Desires that are Excessive

Desires that are Illegitimate

Desires that are Exploitative

Desires that are Exclusive

It leads to dishonesty and injustice.



David saw and desired Bathsheba. (Do not covet.)

David took Bathsheba. (Do not steal.)

David got her pregnant. (Do not commit adultery.)

David arranged for Uriah's death. (Do not murder.)

It leads to hurt, pain, and destruction.

David's son died, leaving him distraught.

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Our society gives us false standards for what love should be... fun, exciting, heated, and passionate. When people/spouses don't measure up to the false standard, then they go looking for other alternatives to solve their problem.

It leads to insatiable demands.

In our recent expanding economy, we want people to have jobs.

- We need to increase production of goods.
- We need to sell more product.
- → We need people to buy more.
- We need to manipulate the consumer.

It leads to worshipping the idol of self-interest and personal gain.

Coveting is a self-centered act.



How Can We Respond to Coveting?

1. We need to be obedient to God.

- No means no.
- What motivates us to covet?
- We need to seek contentment and peace.

2. We need to spend more time with the Word of God and in prayer.

- We need to recognize what is right and wrong.
- When we sin, we need to confess and change.

How Can We Respond to Coveting?

3. We need to readjust our lifestyles.

- We need to live the way God would have us.
- We need to be aware of status-symbol buying.





 We need to give to church and charities.

How Can We Respond to Coveting?

3. We need to readjust our lifestyles. (cont'd)

 We need to recognize the problems that can be caused by instant gratification.






- Be need to be aware of advertising and what it can do to you if you let it.

What motivates you toward coveting and what are you going to do to resist it?




Applying the Lesson to Your Life
