Why was it important for Jesus to appear before people following the resurrection?




- 1. Demonstrated Jesus' victory over death
- 2. Vindicated Jesus as righteous
- 3. Confirmed Jesus' divine identity
- 4. Led to Jesus' ascension and heavenly reign
- 5. Guaranteed the believer's present forgiveness and justification
- 6. Gave believers hope of eternal life in Jesus.
- 7. Gave us eyewitnesses!

Two Meals in the Bible

Adam & Eve ate the fruit.

What happened? In a moment of rebellion, they ate the fruit. What did they discover? Creation then was subjected to decay and death.





Cleopas & Another ate with Jesus.

What happened? Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it, and their eyes were opened.

What did they discover? Death had been defeated!

WHAT DO WE LEARN FROM THE EMMAUS STORY?


- 1. Bring our concerns to Jesus.
- 2. Be prepared to share Scripture, especially the stories of Jesus with strangers.
- 3. Learn to listen to Jesus. The Holy Spirit will explain, lead, and comfort us. The Holy Spirit will give us the words to say when we need to speak.

Iron Cooking Pot vs Stainless Steel Cooking Pot




God's people needed to be set apart.

After the exodus, the Israelites were sandwiched between Egypt and Canaan. Both were polytheistic lands.

Today, we live surrounded by people worshipping other gods. We are to live in and not of the world.

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2:9



God's people needed to know God.

Long ago, the people learned about God through the Law and the prophets. Now that Jesus has come, we know God through knowing Jesus.

I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; you shall have no other gods before me. Exodus 20:2-3

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you really know me, you will know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him." John 14:5-7



God's people needed to live lives pleasing to God.

The Israelites needed to follow God's Law so that they could live the best and safest life possible.

Jesus expands this understanding to include loving God and neighbor.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and love your neighbor as yourself. Luke 10:27



But the Law couldn't SAVE!

Jesus came to save!
