




Memory Verse

Ark of the Covenant

The Land

God promised them the land.

Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your

offspring I will give this land."

Genesis 12:7 ESV



So Joshua took the entire

land, just as the Lord had directed Moses, and he gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their tribal divisions.

Then the land had rest from war.

Joshua II:23 NIV

Leadership & The Land

Abraham - Joshua

God chose Abraham. Genesis 12:1-3

God guided Isaac to lead. Genesis 26:1-6

God called Jacob. Genesis 35:10-12


God through Joseph remembered the land. Genesis 50:24

God directed Moses concerning the land. Numbers 34:1-12

God led **Joshua** to lead them to enter the land. *Deut. 31:1-3*

The Leadership is God initiated.

The transition from Moses to Joshua was a smooth succession with no fighting or hostile takeover.



Provision

The land provided areas for growing crops and vineyard and for herding sheep and cattle.

Why is the land important?

Permanence The land was home and a place to bury the dead.

Covenantal

The giving of the land was based on the unconditional covenant from God. It was the place where God could create God's nation.

Ark of the Covenant



In the NIV translation, there are 67 references in the Old and New Testament.

Ark of the Covenant

God told Moses to make the Ark and gave Moses the detailed plan for its

construction.

The Ark was to hold the Ten Commandments.

Exodus 25:10-22



What do we know about the Ark of the Covenant?



Ark literally means "chest".

It was of wood overlaid with gold.

The lid held 2 cherubim looking at one another. Between them was mercy seat.

There were 2 rings on each side where poles could be inserted for transporting the Ark.

The Ark was respected but not worshipped. God was worshipped.


Rules for the Road

At first, the Ark was portable, and the following rules had to be observed:

In transit, the Ark must be covered. It is not a spectacle.

It must be carried with poles laced through the rings on each side.

Levites were to carry it.



The Ark could NOT be touched!



Where did the Ark go?

It traveled with the Israelites in the wilderness. Numbers 10:33

It crossed the Jordan River. Joshua 3

It encircled Jericho. Joshua 6

It came into camp during military operations. 1 Samuel 4

It was captured by the Philistines. 1 Samuel 4-6

It stayed in Kiriath-Jearim for 20 years. 1 Samuel 7



Where did the Ark go? continued

David sent for it, but Uzzah touched it and died. 2 Samuel 6

David joyfully brought it to Jerusalem. 2 Samuel 6

Solomon put it in the Temple where it stayed. 1 Kings 8

It likely disappeared with the Babylonian invasion of 586 BC.

It will reappear after the 7th trumpet sounds. Revelation 11:19

The Ark and Uzzah

Uzzah broke the rules, thus equating himself with God.

He thought God owed him since he was a good man and would earn favor by saving the Ark from falling.

He touched the Ark and died.




The Ark and Uzzah

What did the Ark Rules teach us?

Our God is not like other gods.

Pagan worshippers longed to touch the statues of the pagan gods so that the pagan would be blessed and receive power from the relics.



Uzzah thought he would go to God with his good works (saving the Ark from the dirt). But the soil was doing what God created it to do. Uzzah was not living the way God created him to live.

The Ark and Uzzah

There is a chasm between God and people. It cannot be bridged by human effort...the bridge cannot be earned by humankind. There must be a sacrifice because there is a debt that needs to be paid.

Jesus is our bridge.

Jesus is the sacrifice.

Out of great love and amazing grace, Jesus did it for us because we could never do it ourselves.

Exodus 25:30 NRSV


How do you know God's Will?

- 4. We need to see God's Power. We need to be prepared to see miracles.


